Details of the trip

Leave St. Asaph, Denbighshire by coach at 6.00 a.m. Tuesday morning, April 18th (picking up points to be arranged later). Arrive at Holyhead for the 8:55 a.m ferry to Dublin. Arrive 1p.m approx, then travel to Carlow and arrive by 2:30 p.m. Stay for 5 nights. It will be possible to tour on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, should you wish. The Festival Ticket will give you free entry to all the events of the Festival mostly in the Seven Oaks Hotel.

Leave at 9 a.m Sunday, April 23rd, with the ship sailing at 3:10 p.m; arrive in Holyhead at 6:30 p.m and return to St. Asaph.(This could change)
